



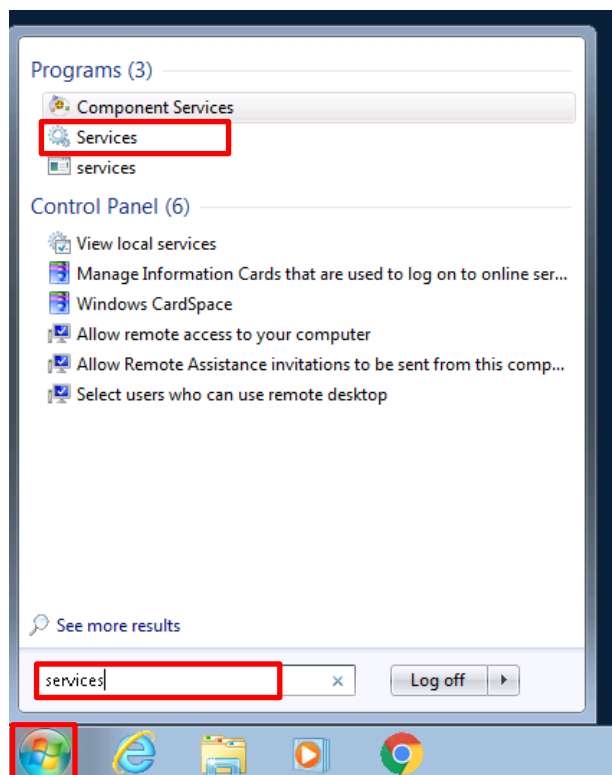
Windows Wired Connects

This guide is for new connections to the UOW wired network at Accommodation.

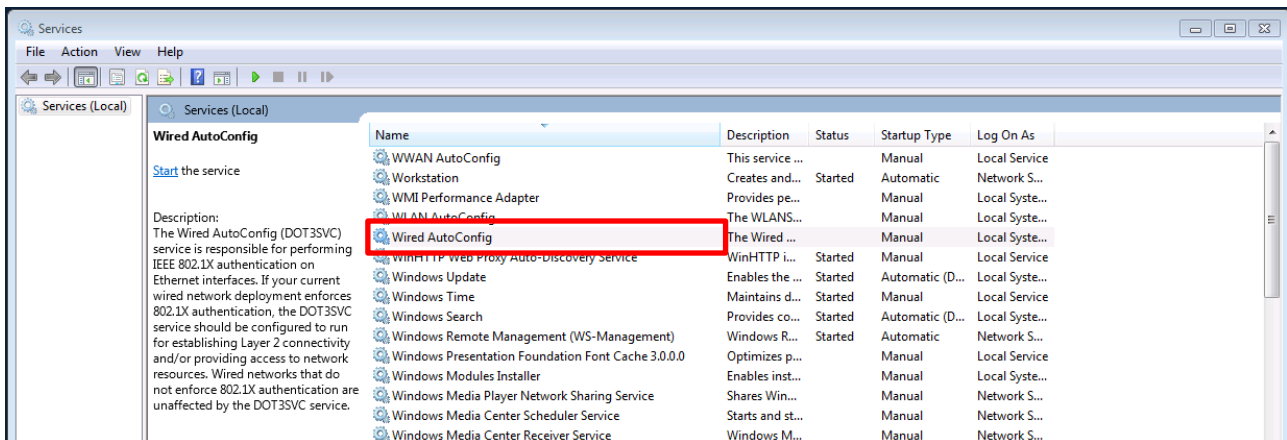
Note: This document only applies to accommodation buildings where students have wall-mounted units in their rooms

1. Click on the Start Menu and search for “services”

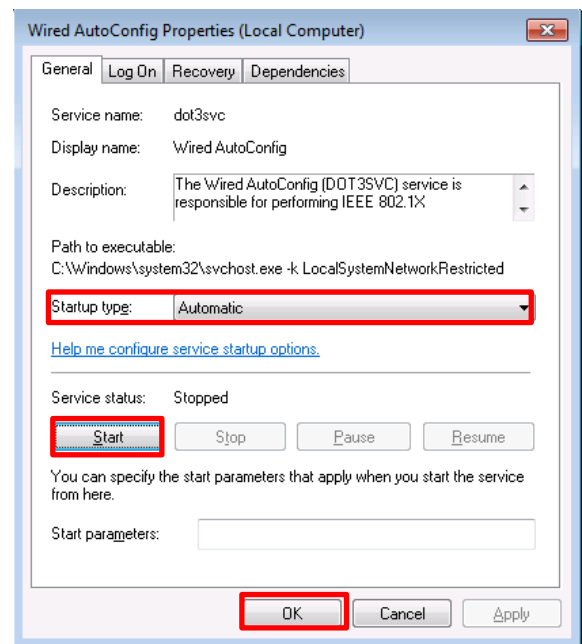
Open **Services**



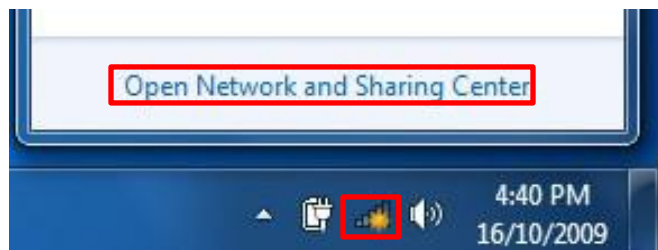
2. Scroll through the list until you find **“Wired AutoConfig”** in the name column and then double click it



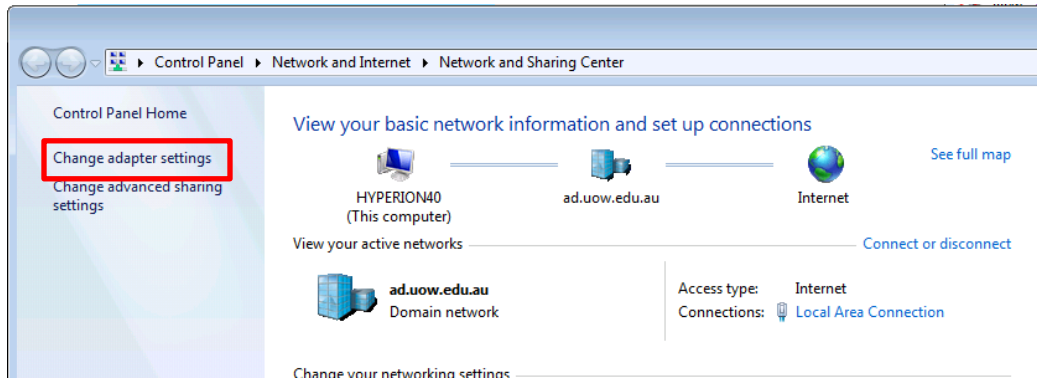
3. Change the Startup type to **“Automatic”**
Click **“Start”** and then **“OK”**



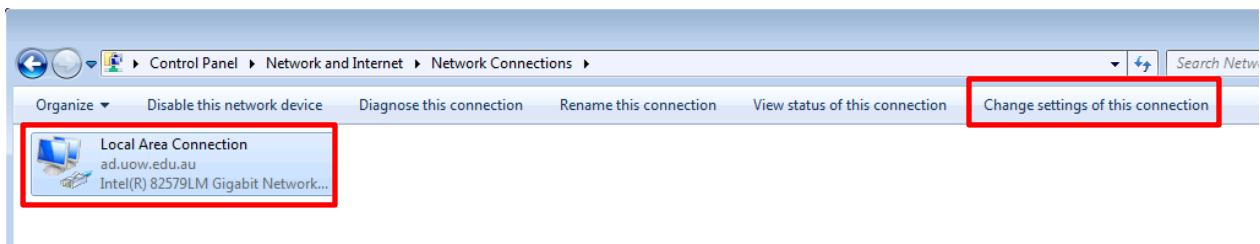
4. Click on the networking icon and select **“Network and Sharing Center”**



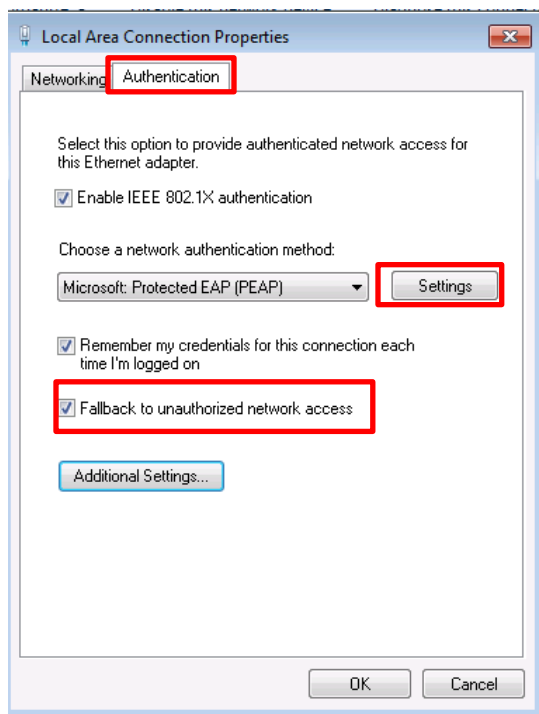
5. Click “Change adapter settings”



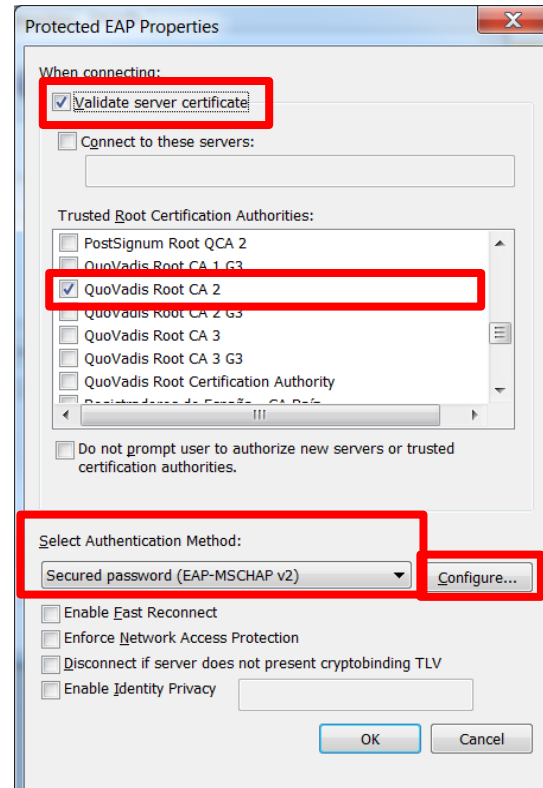
6. Click on “Local Area Connection” and then click “Change settings of this connection”



7. Click “Authentication” and select “Fallback to unauthorized network access”. Then click “Settings”



8. Select **Validate Server Certificate**
9. Select "**QuoVadis Root CA 2**" from the list
10. Set Authentication method to **Secured Password (EAP-MSCHAPv2)**
11. Click **Configure**

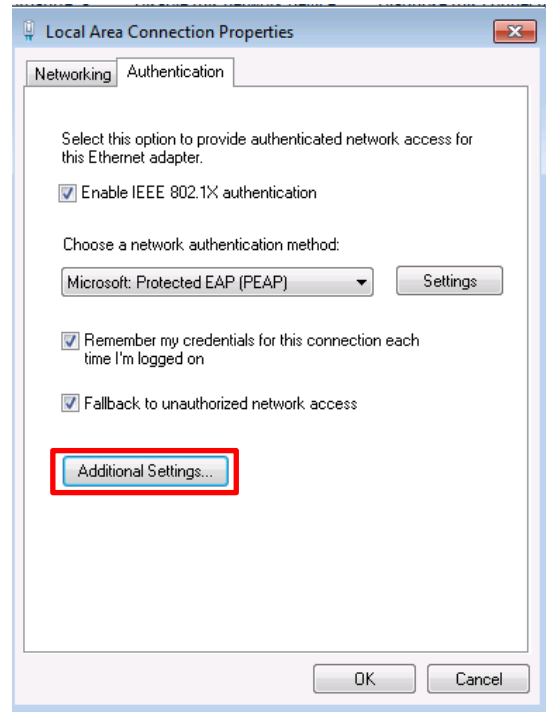


12. Deselect "**Automatically use my windows logon name and password (and domain if any)**".
Your device will not connect if this is selected.

13. Click **OK**



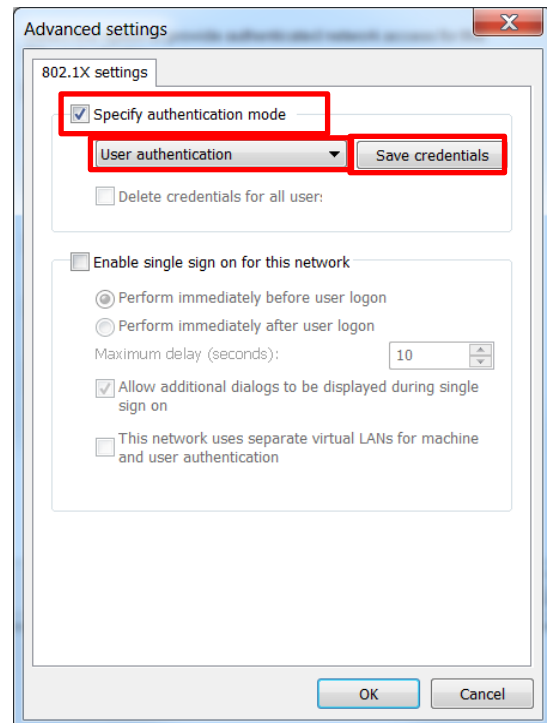
14. Click **“Additional Settings”**



15. Select **“Specify authentication mode”**
select **“User authentication”** from the list

16. Select **“Save Credentials”** and enter your UOW
username and password

Click **“OK”**
