What is involved?

BUS902 involves a 9 day placement program over 3 weeks where students will be matched with a pre-selected Industry. The host organisation will provide the student with tasks, determined as appropriate, in conjunction with the course co-ordinator, where

the student will gain valuable insight within that industry.

The placement will include working on or developing a program or process to complement that organisation with a focus to adding value, to assist and optimise current organisational practice.

At the end of the placement the student will then present the host organisation with a report and/or presentation.

The student is required to attend compulsory workshops/lectures/tutorials and complete a combination of individual and/or group assessments during the trimester as part of the program.

Who can apply?

Students who are enrolled in:

Post Graduate studies, having completed core subjects in either Marketing, Supply Chain, Operations, Quality, Project Management or HR

- * WAM of 65
- * Demonstration of good reflective, critical analytical thinking and essay/ report writing skills
- * Have access to reliable transport
- * Able to commit to the normal terms of engagement for the selected industry for the period of placement

How to apply?

Students follow a 3 step application process;

Step 1:

If the student meets the subject pre-requisites, they will be required to submit an application including a cover letter, resume, copy of enrolment record and apply via the UOW online application form.

Step 2:

If successful in getting through the first stage, the student will be required to attend a video interview with the subject co-ordinator.

Students will be shortlisted for interviews based on performance in steps 1 & 2.

Step 3:

Students are selected based on their application and interview performance.

Students will then be manually enrolled and commence their subject in Week 1 of Trimester 3.

Placement dates will be Week 6, 7 and 8 of Trimester 3 commencing Monday 25th September.

Students will cover aspects of Team work, organisational culture during workshops and meet each week to debrief and discuss their contribution to the host organisation in that preceding week.

The students final mark will be based upon meeting the assessment criteria, which will include, their performance during the placement, their final report and evaluations completed by the Host organisation at the completion of the placement.
