

## GenPal MBS Billing for Cyclic Screening

Although this item number guide does not form part of the GenPal Tool itself, it is included because MBS funding is a key enabler of sustainable and effective integration of GenPal into routine general practice workflows.

Nurse-led GPCCMP monitoring consultations align well with the cyclic GenPal screening model and current MBS claiming requirements. Other nurse-led appointments may also be used opportunistically to support MBS-funded screening consultations, where appropriate. The following table is provided as guidance only. Clinical judgement should always be applied when determining the most appropriate MBS item number for each patient encounter. Practices should check that one of the patient goals in care plan is chronic condition support / monitoring, to meet nurse monitoring MBS requirements.

Action	MBS Item	Claiming Rules
Nurse monitoring F/U on scores	10997 10987	Maximum 5 per calendar year
GP GPCCMP review	967 / 92030	Minimum 3 months after plan 3 maximum per calendar year
GP Consultation	23	No maximum but can't co-claim general consultations with CDM items on same day.
Multidisciplinary care plan	729 / 92026	Generally, once every 12 months
Multidisciplinary review	731 / 92027	Minimum 3 months after plan
