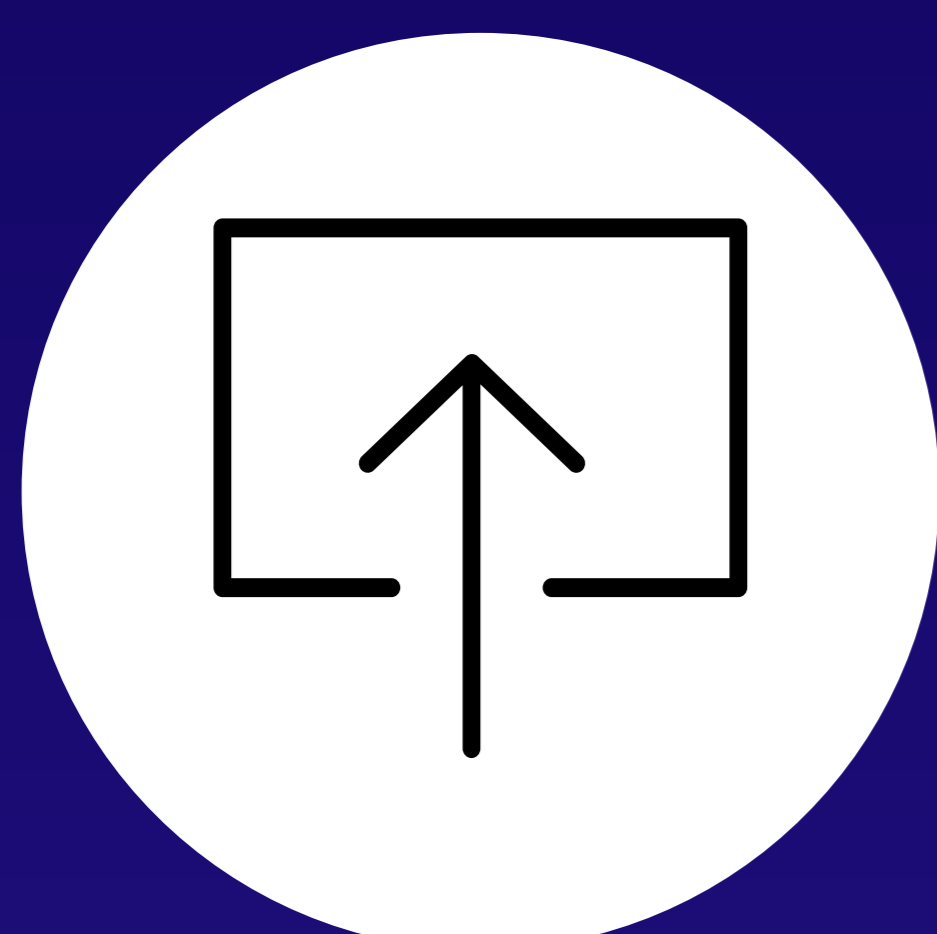

ACHs send information about
palliative aged care outcomes to
PACOP (this does **not** include any
identifying information about
residents)

PACOP analyses the
information to identify
opportunities for ACHs to
improve the care they provide



PACOP provides reports & education
to ACHs to help them continuously
improve the quality of palliative care
they provide to residents



PACOP, ACHs, their organisations
& researchers use the data to
improve palliative care for all
residents in all ACHs
