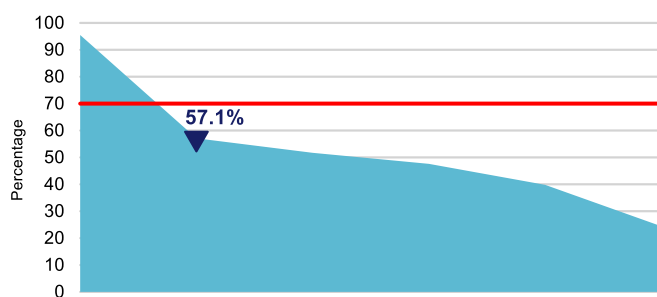

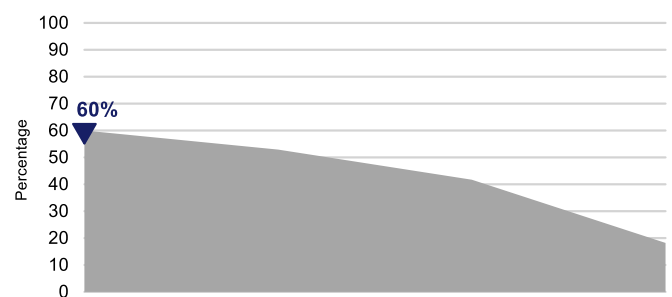

Average pain (indicator)



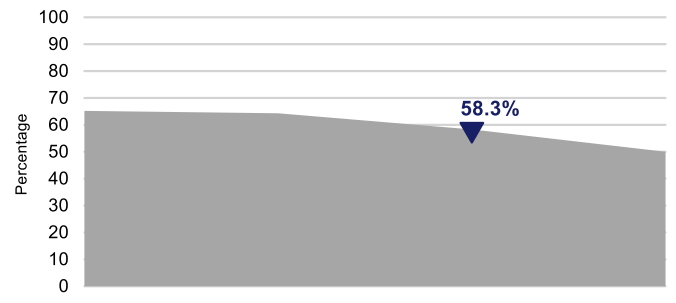
Patients with at least moderate average pain at referral who make clinically significant improvement at episode end (%)
