## Who are ePPOC?

ePPOC work with pain management services to improve outcomes for people who experience chronic pain. ePPOC provide the questionnaires that you receive at referral, during, and end of treatment.



## Your Participation

ePPOC questionnaires help clinics assess your treatment needs and responses. Services also send information about their patient outcomes to ePPOC. **ePPOC does not receive any names, addresses or medical record numbers.**

## Improving Quality of Care

ePPOC analyses the information and provides reports and support to help services identify opportunities to improve the care they provide to their patients.



## Supporting Research

ePPOC and participating clinical services undertake research on persistent pain using this information.
