

# Enterprise One Pain Management Service

Report dashboard – 1 July 2023 to 30 June 2024



## Profile of patients who completed a referral questionnaire (n = 97)

59%	female	12.6	average age (years)
10%	Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander	14%	living in area of highest disadvantage
67%	had pain for more than 12 months	41%	outside healthy weight range
40%	carer work impairment due to child's pain	4.4	average school days missed last 2 weeks

74% patients with at least moderate pain severity

86% patients with impaired health related quality of life

82% patients with at least moderate functional disability

5% patients taking opioids daily (excluding codeine)

## Services provided in this period

96 patients started an episode of care

36 patients assessed by a multidisciplinary team

84 patients started a treatment pathway

583.4 hours of in clinic care

71.6 hours of telehealth

Median wait time from referral to episode start **26.0 days**

Average length of episode of care **357.6 days**

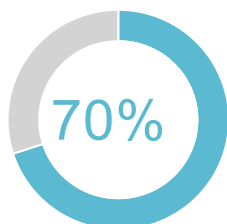
Average treatment time per episode **12.3 hours**

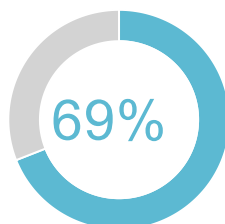
63 patients completed an episode of care
