Top tips to keep your digital life secure

- 1 Use a unique password for every account, including your UOW account. Make your passwords unique and complex by combining uppercase and lowercase letters, numbers, and special characters (better still, use passphrases).
- **2** Longer is better aim for at least 12 characters or more.
- **3** Avoid common or easily guessable words like 'password', '123456', or your name.
- **4** Enable Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) wherever possible for an extra layer of security
- **5** Change your password(s) regularly.
