

Student Ambassadors Learning & Teaching

One of the educational priorities for 2016 is to improve the student voice – to provide more opportunities for students to work alongside UOW staff to share ideas and opinions on how UOW functions. To support this priority we are recruiting 5 Student Ambassadors Learning & Teaching (SALTs) to work in LTC on some key projects. The successful SALTs will decide on the projects themselves and then work with LTC staff to complete them. The topic areas include:

- **Improving the student voice at UOW**
- **Using technology to enhance learning**
- **Creating learning spaces**
- **Exploring assessment and feedback**

SALTs will be recruited for one or two semesters (depending on the scope of the proposed project) and will receive an honorarium of up to \$4,000 for their work. Each SALT will also be offered the opportunity to contribute and attend an external event (registration, accommodation and travel paid), including:

- OLT Transforming Practice Project (Students as Partners) – Brisbane (April/November)
- STARS Conference – Perth (June)
- HERDSA Conference – Perth (July)
