

How is my Honours grade calculated?

The following formula is used to calculate your Honours grade:

$$\text{Honours grade} = \frac{\text{Sum of (subject credit} \times \text{mark} \times \text{weight)}}{\text{Sum of (subject credit} \times \text{weight)}}$$

Weight 1 for 400 level; 0 for 300, 200, 100 level. (Only 400 level subjects are counted)

Example: How to calculate your Final Honours grade

Subject	Credit points	Final Mark	Subject credit points × final mark
EDRT401	24	83	24 × 83 × 1 = 1992
EDPD401	6	72	6 × 72 × 1 = 432
EDAR401	6	75	6 × 75 × 1 = 450
EDPD402	12	82	12 × 82 × 1 = 984
TOTALS	48		3858

$$1. \text{ Sum of (subject credit} \times \text{mark} \times \text{weight)} = 1992 + 432 + 450 + 984 \\ = \mathbf{3858}$$

$$2. \text{ Sum of (subject credit} \times \text{weight)} = 24 + 6 + 6 + 12 \\ = \mathbf{48}$$

$$3. \text{ Honours grade calculation} = \mathbf{3858 \div 48}$$

Honours grade = 80.375 (class 2, Division 1)

85%-100% : class 1

75%- 85% : class 2, Division 1

65%- 75% : class 2, Division 2

50%- 65% : class 3

0%- 50% : Honours\ not awarded
