



2015 YEAR 11 ACT SENIOR COLLEGES SCIENCE-TECHNOLOGY-ENGINEERING-MATHEMATICS (STEM) COMPETITION

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The Competition is open to Year 11 ACT Students who are studying Physics, Information Technology, Design and Technology, Electronics, Engineering Science, Automotive Studies, CAD Drawing, Mathematics, Chemistry or any other Year 11 ACT subject with an Engineering application.
 - Awards will be based on portfolios, reports and practical projects prepared by the students.
 - The submissions must cover Engineering applications.
 - Each school will select the “best two” entries from its students for each subject area. If one of these entries has not been prepared by a female, a third entry may be submitted.
 - If 1 of these 2/3 entries referred to above has not been prepared by an Indigenous student, a 3rd/4th entry may be submitted from an Indigenous student for consideration for the Indigenous Students’ Awards.
 - For single sex schools, a maximum of 3 entries in each subject area in each Competition can be submitted. A third entry will be accepted from a single sex school where the selected best two entries have not been prepared by an Indigenous student and where the 3rd entry is work prepared by an Indigenous Student.
2. Each entry has to:
 - i. have been undertaken during the Year 11 Course i.e. January 2015 - November 2015.
 - ii. have been prepared by the person entering the Competition.
 - iii. have the portfolio submitted as a “hard” copy (either original or double-sided copy).
 - iv. not include large amounts of irrelevant material which is not reviewed, such as that sourced from the internet.

Note: There is no maximum/minimum length requirement.
3. Entries are to be registered via the online registration system. To access this system, please go to the Competitions’ website: <http://eis.uow.edu.au/highschoolcomp/index.html> and click on the button ‘2015 Registration of Entries’.
4. Entries must be submitted by no later than Friday, 13th November 2015.
