You can help to ensure that your bike is safe and secure by following these simple tips.

1. Don't use chains and padlocks, these are easily defeated
2. Make sure you use a solid D-Bolt to secure your bike to a rack, even when you use a secure bike store.
3. Secure bike stores are vulnerable when your fellow bike riders don't ensure the bike store door is left secure when they leave.
4. Or thieves piggy back into a store when an authorised user arrives or leaves.
5. Don't leave any valuable property with your bike
6. Keep a photograph, serial numbers, manufacturer, model, proof of purchase and any identifiable features about your bike in case of theft
7. Secure your bike against theft
