2022 WUPA ANNUAL GENERAL ELECTION

In accordance with Section 4.4 of the Constitution of the Wollongong University Postgraduate Association (WUPA) and related WUPA Regulations Governing Elections, the Annual General Elections of WUPA shall be held by way of online election from:

9am Wednesday 5 October until 5pm Friday 7 October 2022.

Voting will be conducted online through SOLS. Access to online voting will be available continuously from 9am Wednesday 5 October 2022 until 5pm Friday 7 October 2022. Voters will be able to seek assistance by emailing uow-elections@uow.edu.au on the days on which voting is open.

In accordance with Section 4.2.1 of the WUPA Constitution, the following positions shall be elected by and from the eligible postgraduate students of the University at the Annual General Election. The following positions are to be contested at the election; for the term of office 1 January 2023 – 31 December 2023:

- **President**
- **Vice-President (Coursework)**
- **Vice-President (Research)**
- **Secretary Treasurer**
- **Women's Officer**
- **International Students' Officer**
- **Koori Officer**
- **Events Officer**
- **Media Officer**
- **Honours Student Officer**
- **External Students Officer**
- **General Representatives (3 Positions)**

All UOW 2022 Elections will be conducted in accordance with current NSW Government Health COVID-19 advice and restrictions.

MAKING A NOMINATION

In accordance with Section 4.1 of the WUPA Regulations Governing Elections, **Nominations will open at midday, 12pm on Tuesday 6 September 2022.**

To be a candidate in the WUPA Annual General Elections, you must be an enrolled postgraduate student proceeding toward a postgraduate degree or diploma or a discrete honours program at the University of Wollongong at the time and date specified for the closing of nominations and must satisfy the criteria specified in Section 5.1.2 of the WUPA Regulations Governing Elections.

Nominations will close at midday, 12pm on Tuesday 20 September 2022.

Nominations must be made in writing using the Nomination Form. Nomination Forms will be available online on the [UOW Elections](#) website. The Nomination Form must be signed by a proposer and a seconder whose names also appear on the Roll of Postgraduate Students at the time of the closing of nominations. Candidate Statements and photographs may accompany the nomination but only in the format detailed on the Nomination Form.

Nominations, Candidate Statements and photographs are to be lodged with the Returning Officer via email to uow-elections@uow.edu.au no later than the time and date for the close of nominations (**midday, 12pm on Tuesday 20 September 2022**).
