

277th Council Meeting: 9 October 2020

UOW COUNCIL MEETING SUMMARY

The following matters, which may be of interest to the staff and students of the University, were considered by the University Council at its meeting of 9 October 2020.

Due to the government's restrictions regarding the spread of COVID-19, Council members participated in the Council meeting on 9 October 2020 in person or via videoconference (Webex).

This was Ms McLoughlin's first meeting of Council as Chancellor of the University. In opening the meeting, the Chancellor thanked the University for the priviledge of being entrusted with the role and expressed her enthusiasm to continue to build upon the outstanding stewardship and governance of Chancellor Broadbent. The Chancellor spoke to the challenges currently faced by the Higher Education sector and the broader economic environment.

Vice-Chancellor's Report

The Vice-Chancellor briefly highlighted the following items in his report:

- The successful opening of the Jillian Broadbent Building and the launch of the Nowra Agri-Business Innovation Hub.
- The temporary closure of two student accommodation residences in 2021 due to the impact of COVID-19.
- The work undertaken for the return to campus teaching for Spring session.
- The food on campus initiative. The Vice-Chancellor commended staff for volunteering in providing food banks for UOW students across the state.
- The upcoming Early Admission conversion activity which is expected to be one of the most competitive experienced as future students have multiple university offers.
- As a consequence of the variations to the Enterprise Bargaining Agreements being approved, the Special Additional Leave Scheme (SAL) dates for 2021 and 2022 have been finalised. The Early Retirement Scheme offered to staff has closed and outcomes from this scheme are being finalised.
- The successful and CovidSafe Fellowship & Alumni Awards Dinner held on 8 October 2020. The Vice-Chancellor thanked all staff involved in the event.
- The large volume of work undertaken in digitalisation including: a suite of online Cyber Security postgraduate courses for early 2021; procurement of lifelong learing modules and micro-credentials, and a portfolio of subjects being curated to align with the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals.
- Due to border closures, up to 4000 of UOW's international students could remain onshore over the summer period and the University is looking at ways in which to engage and support those students over this period.
- Ms Stefania Peracchi came first in the UOW Three Minute Thesis competition and has been named winner of the People's Choice Award at the Asia-Pacific 3MT finals for her research in making space travel safer.
