

284th Council Meeting: 3 December 2021

UOW COUNCIL MEETING SUMMARY

The following matters, which may be of interest to the staff and students of the University, were considered by the University Council at its meeting of 3 December 2021.

The Vice-Chancellor led a Strategic Update presentation and highlighted the following matters:

- proposed Senior Executive portfolio realignment;
- the challenges and opportunities faced by the University during 2021;
- consideration of the Strategic Plan goals and alignment to the 2030 and Beyond report, including identifying the upcoming two years and the importance of moving in the right direction over this period;
- senior executive priorities to drive KPI achievement, with a focus on narrowing work to a key number of activities for KPI-driven performance; and
- the whole-of-institution focus for the next two years.

The Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Education), Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Global Strategy), and Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Health and Sustainable Futures) also provided strategic update presentations relating to their portfolios.

Deputy Chancellor Election

Council re-elected Mr Rob Ryan to the position of Deputy Chancellor for another term of office, effective immediately.

UOW Global Enterprises 2021 Year in Review

Council received a presentation by Mr Peter Robson, Chair of UOW Global Enterprises (UOWGE) Board on UOWGE's activities, challenges and opportunities during 2021.

UN Climate Change Project

Council received a presentation by University students Mr Ben Hamill and Ms Grace Mahon on the student-led UOW Youth Climate Change Project.

2020-2025 Strategic Plan Transformative Priority Update: Student Access and Participation/Social Inclusion/Global and Social Responsibility
