



2020 University of Wollongong Full Fee Paying Remote Bursary

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. OVERVIEW

- a) As a result of COVID-19 the University of Wollongong ABN 61 060 567 686 (“UOW”) is delivering on-campus subjects remotely and is now offering a Full Fee Paying Remote Bursary (“Bursary”) on the terms set out in these Terms and Conditions.
- b) The Bursary is offered to all domestic and international students (“Student”) who pay the full fee for coursework for a Session and meet the eligibility requirements outlined in these Terms and Conditions.
- c) UOW is sponsoring the Bursary.
- d) The Student has accepted to be bound by these Terms and Conditions when receiving the Bursary.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- a) To be eligible for the Bursary, a Student must meet the following eligibility requirements by the Census Date for the Session:
 - i. be studying all subjects remotely at UOW in a course which ordinarily has an on campus or flexible mode of delivery;
 - ii. not have the capacity to undertake face to face study, as determined by UOW;
 - iii. remain enrolled as an undergraduate or postgraduate coursework student at UOW;
 - iv. not be eligible for a Commonwealth Supported Place (as defined by the Australian Government);
 - v. for domestic students, have any FEE-HELP loan option set to ‘DFP FEE-HELP Partial’ by the last day to add a subject in the applicable Session; and
 - vi. not be enrolled in a higher degree research, exchange or non-award program.
- b) The Student must meet the eligibility requirements outlined in clause 2(a) by the Census Date for the applicable Session. If they meet these eligibility requirements after the Census Date for a Session then they will be unable to receive the Bursary for that Session.
- c) For the avoidance of doubt, if a course is deemed capable by UOW of being undertaken face to face then all domestic students and onshore international students would be deemed capable of undertaking face to face study however international students who are offshore and unable to obtain a visa or enter Australia would not be deemed capable of undertaking face to face study.

3. CONDITIONS

- a) The Bursary consists of a tuition fee waiver of 10%, which will be applied directly to the Student’s tuition fees at UOW following commencement of the Session and by the Census Date.
- b) This Bursary offer only applies to UOW’s Trimester 2, Spring Session and/or Trimester 3 2020 and is not deferrable.
- c) The Bursary may be stacked with other University of Wollongong scholarships and bursaries in accordance with clause 4(c) of these Terms and Conditions.

4. PAYMENT

- a) The Bursary is in the form of a waiver of 10% of the Student's tuition fees. The Bursary will be applied to the Student's tuition fees following commencement of the Session provided they meet the eligibility requirements by the Census Date for that Session.
- b) The Bursary is not redeemable for cash and is not transferable to any other costs.
- c) If a student has other UOW fee waiver scholarships or bursaries the Bursary discount will be applied as a successive discount. For the avoidance of doubt, this means that the discount under this Bursary will be applied to the fee for the coursework after the initial scholarship or bursary has been applied.
- d) UOW has a variable fees policy ("Fee Policy") where increases to tuition fees may occur annually. Students receiving the Bursary are not exempt from UOW's Fees Policy. A copy of UOW's Fee Policy is available at <https://documents.uow.edu.au/about/policy/UOW058686.html>.
- e) The Student will be required to pay the balance of tuition fees not covered by this Bursary by the required payment due date for the Session of study at UOW.

5. TERMINATION

- a) Failure to meet any of these Terms and Conditions may result in the Bursary being terminated, the tuition fee waiver being removed and the student being responsible to repay to UOW an amount equal to the Bursary. UOW may withhold academic results and documents until this payment is received.
- b) UOW reserves the right to remove the Bursary and associated tuition fee waiver at its absolute discretion before it is paid to the Student in accordance with clause 5 of these Terms and Conditions.

6. GENERAL

- a) Capitalised terms used in these Terms and Conditions are defined in the body of these Terms and Conditions. The following terms are defined as follows:
 - i. "**Census Date**" means the last day to withdraw from subjects for a Session, as defined by UOW from time to time and published on the UOW website; and
 - ii. "**Session**" means Trimester 2, Spring Session and/or Trimester 3 2020 as defined by UOW from time to time and published on the UOW website.
- b) These Terms and Conditions may only be altered in writing signed by both the Student and UOW.
- c) If part or all of any clause of these Terms and Conditions is void, illegal or unenforceable it will be severed and will not affect the continued operation of the remaining provisions.
- d) The Student may not assign or sublicense any of their rights or obligations under these Terms and Conditions to a third party.
- e) These Terms and Conditions are governed by the law applicable in New South Wales and the Student submits to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts in New South Wales.
