NIASRA is a highly performing research institute in the School of Mathematics and Applied Statistics (SMAS) at the University of Wollongong. It currently contains the Centre for Biometry and Bioinformatics, the Centre for Environmental Informatics, the Centre for Sample Survey Methodology, and the Statistical Consulting Centre.
