Selecting the best genotypes - analysing pasture variety trial workshop

27 FEBRUARY | 2014

An introductory course which will provide hands-on training in exploratory data analysis and spatial analysis of pasture variety field trials will be conducted at the Wagga Wagga Agricultural Institute (WWAI) from the 11th to the 13th of August. The aim of the course is to provide breeding companies an introductory course on statistical methods which will enable them to select their best performing lines for commercial release. The overall aim of these types of courses is to improve the pool of pasture varieties farmers have access to. The course will be presented by Dr. Simon Diffey (Research Fellow, CBB) and Dr. Bev Gogel (Biometry Hub, University of Adelaide).
