APPLICATION FOR SUPERVISOR ALLOCATION LAW (HONOURS) PROGRAM (2025)

AM I ELIGIBLE TO APPLY?

To be eligible to apply for entry into the Bachelor of Laws (Honours) Program, you must:

1. Attain a Weighted Average Mark (WAM) of 70 or above based on all LLB 100 and 200 level core subjects. You can calculate your WAM [here](#).
2. Consider the main academic requirements for successfully completing the LLB Honours subject (LLB4402 Legal Research Thesis):
 - It is an annual subject – you must therefore start it at the beginning of the Autumn semester and complete it by the end of the Spring semester.
 - You must attend eight compulsory seminars on legal research methodologies during the Autumn semester.
 - You must attend before the mid-year recess a day-long academic conference in which you will present the advances in your research.
 - You must submit a 10,000-12,000 word Legal Research Thesis by the end of the Spring semester.
3. Complete an [Application for Course Transfer](#) and submit it to AskUOW via askuow@uow.edu.au. Make sure you submit the application no more than three months and at least three weeks before the beginning of the Honours course (i.e., between November and the first week of February). Submission of the Application for Course Transfer does not require previous approval from the Honours Coordinator.

(Note: There is no requirement to identify potential supervisors at this stage, but no more than three months and at least three weeks before the beginning of the semester, you must submit an email to the Honours coordinator nominating a supervisor with whom you feel you can work comfortably. Please consider that the Dean of Law will appoint your supervisor, so it is advisable to have backup supervisors in mind, given your first choice may not be available for you).
