APPLICATION FOR TRANSFER INTO THE BACHELOR OF LAWS (HONOURS) PROGRAM (2021/2022)

AM I ELIGIBLE TO APPLY?

To be eligible to apply for entry into the Bachelor of Laws (Honours) Program, you must:

1. Attain a Weighted Average Mark (WAM 4) of 70 or above based on all LLB 100 and 200 level core subjects assessed at the end of your second year of full-time enrolment or equivalent, plus 48 credit points on 100-level LLB subjects and 42 credit points on 200-level LLB subjects. You can calculate your WAM [here](#).
2. Consider the main academic requirements for successfully completing the LLB Honours subject:
 - It is an annual subject – you must therefore enroll at the beginning of the Autumn semester, and complete it by the end of the Spring semester.
 - You must attend eight (8) compulsory seminars on legal research methodologies during the Autumn semester.
 - You must attend before the mid-year recess a day-long moot academic conference in which you will present the advances in your research.
 - You must submit a 10,000-12,000 words Legal Research Thesis by the end of the Spring semester.

Please consider that the Dean of Law will appoint your supervisor, so it is advisable to have backup supervisors in mind, given your first choice may not be available for you).
