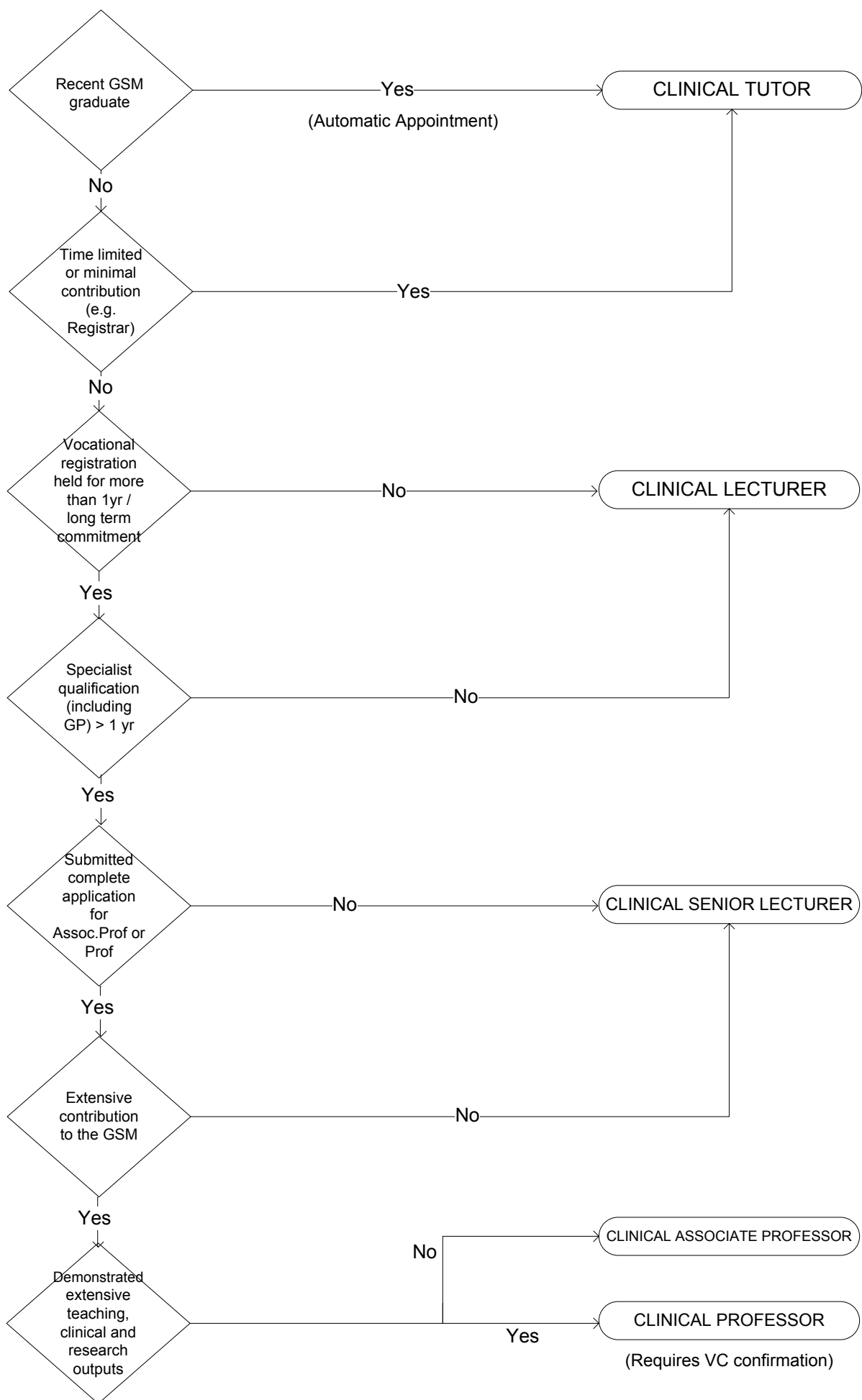


SOM Clinical Academic Appointment Assessment Process



Criteria for Honorary Clinical Associate Professor (Level D):

The applicant is expected to:

- Make a significant contribution to all activities of the School of Medicine, and
- Play a key role within their profession or discipline.
- Provide leadership
- Maintain the reputation of the medical school
- Have a national reputation related to your field of expertise

Honorary Clinical Academics at this level may be appointed in recognition of their academic excellence, as demonstrated by:

- Academic Distinction in their field, and
- An outstanding contribution to two or more of the following areas:
 - a) research or scholarly activity;
 - b) teaching;
 - c) leadership in teaching, research, and professional activities.

Criteria for Honorary Clinical Professor (Level E):

In addition to the above, the applicant is expected to exercise a special responsibility in providing leadership and in fostering excellence in three or more of the following areas: clinical practice, research; teaching and examination; administration; professional activities, or policy development in the academic discipline within the School of Medicine. Honorary Clinical Professors are expected to have an international reputation.

The Honorary Clinical Professor will be recognised as a leading authority in their discipline. Applicants seeking these levels may be required to attend an interview with the Honorary Clinical Academic Appointments Committee. Applications seeking the level of Honorary Clinical Professor will require Vice Chancellor approval, following recommendation of the Honorary Clinical Academic Appointments Committee.
