#### **PURPOSE**

Reflect on the questions below:

#### **TYPE OF ASSIGNMENT**

Consider the following:

- 1. Are you being asked to describe something, pose an argument, or connect a theoretical approach to some phenomenon?
- 2. Are you required to download data and analyse it critically?
- 3. What is critical analysis?
- 4. Do we have to write in a narrative form? Descriptive form? Analytical form?
- 5. Do we discuss opposing views? Or just state the research?
- 6. Are we to make recommendations? If yes, do they have to be backed by authors? Or make recommendations off your head?

### RESEARCH

Consider the following:

- 1. Is there a minimum number of references required?
- 2. What types of references are required (journal articles, primary sources, scholarly or peer revierwed)?
- 3. Where can you find relevant resources?
