CREDIT TRANSFER BETWEEN TAFE NSW AND UNIVERSITY OF WOLLONGONG

For TAFE/AQF graduates applying to UOW, Credit transfer (also known as 'advanced standing' or 'credit exemption') is the awarding of credit towards completion of a UOW degree based on previous studies. Many NSW TAFE Diploma and Advanced Diploma programs are recognised for credit transfer at UOW as they contain studies equivalent to individual subjects in some UOW Bachelor degrees.

This document should be used as a guide only. All applications for admission and credit towards UOW courses will be assessed on a case-by-case basis.
