

# VICE-CHANCELLOR'S AWARD FOR GLOBAL STRATEGY

## NOMINATION PROCESS

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The information regarding this award should be read in conjunction with the [Vice-Chancellor's Award Guideline](#).

### What is the Vice-Chancellor's Award for Global Strategy?

The Global Strategy Award recognises staff who have achieved outstanding success, given exceptional service and/or have demonstrated extraordinary leadership or innovation in their work with a specific emphasis on driving UOW's global strategy and profile.

### Who is eligible?

- This award is open to members of the academic and professional services staff as an individual or a team.
- Staff must be employed either on a permanent basis or temporary contract of at least two years and must have been employed for a period of no less than 12 months prior to the date of nomination.

### What is the Selection Criteria?

The Global Strategy Award will be for achievements in the 12 months preceding the closing date for nominations and will consider the outcome and impact of this contribution. The nomination will meet one or more of the following selection criteria. An outstanding achievement or success directly contributing to the realisation of UOW's Global Strategy.

- Outstanding service, demonstrated initiative or enhancement to work practices which has been implemented and has a demonstrated value to the Division/Faculty /University in its global activities.
- Demonstrated strong and sustained leadership and innovation in internationalisation.

### How to nominate?

A nomination is made by two nominators, with one nominator normally outside of the nominee's own unit, school or centre, on the form below.

The nomination requires endorsement by the relevant Executive Dean/Faculty Executive Manager/Director of the nominee's business unit. Self-nominations are acceptable.

The Primary Nominator is required to provide a description of the achievement and address the award criteria, providing examples to support their claims. The Primary Nominator will take responsibility for completion and submission of the nomination form to the International Relations Administrator within the International Engagement and Coordination Division by the due date.
