2021 Image Competition - MicroWorld

Terms and Conditions

- 1. The Fluorescence Analysis Facility (FAF) proudly presents its first Image Competition: MicroWorld and MicroWorld in Motion
- 2. Information on entry and prizes form part of the 'Terms and Conditions'. Entry to the competition is confirmed via acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
- 3. Entry is open to all researchers based at the University of Wollongong. Images/videos must have been taken using a light or fluorescence microscope.
- 4. The competition for entry submissions commences on Wednesday 22nd September 2021. Entries close 5pm AEST on Wednesday 20th October 2021. No late submission will be accepted.
- 5. The competition has two categories: (i) a single static image (MicroWorld) and a movie (MicroWorld in Motion). Submissions into either category can be or fixed or live samples.
- 6. Each participant may submit a maximum of THREE images and ONE movie in total.
- 7. Entrants are to submit their images along with their name and a caption or description of the image (maximum 100 words). Your image(s) must be uploaded electronically via the Googleform and associated Googledrive.
- 8. The image file format should be TIFF or video format. Image files should be high resolution with a recommended file size equal to or greater than 3-4 MB, and videos no larger than 100MB.
- 9. Entrants declare that their submissions are their own original images, and do not violate any copyright. Each entrant grants FAF the right to reproduce, publish, transmit or otherwise communicate to the public their entry (with credit given to the entrant).
- 10. Entrants give the University of Wollongong the non-exclusive right to use images for marketing and promotional purposes in the future, without permission or payment.
- 11. All valid entries will be judged by a panel appointed by the FAF who, at their discretion, will select images for display. Of these, the best entries will be selected as prize winners. All entries will be judged considering the overall aesthetics of the image, technical difficulty in obtaining the image, research relevance and originality.
- 12. The winners of this competition will win ONE of the prizes kindly donated by our sponsor.
- 13. The prize winners will be notified by email at the end of the fluorescence microscopy seminar series on the 26th October 2021.
- 14. The prize is not transferable, exchangeable, or redeemable for cash.
- 15. If, for any reason the Competition is not capable of running as planned, FAF reserves the right to modify the terms of the competition, including the prize and these Terms and Conditions.
