Editorial Note:

The spellings encountered in Conrad Martens' "Account of Pictures painted at N.S. Wales" are quite variable, such that surnames and titles are often spelt a number of different ways e.g. "Dumarick" and "Dumaresq". Problems also arise due to difficulties in distinguishing between certain letters such as "J", "G", "L" and "C" when they are used for Christian names. Spellings are as written by Martens in his account book, however corrections have been made where obvious. For example, "Dumaresq" is the correct spelling, and not "Dumarick".

Third son of Archibald Bell (1773-1837). Born at "Belmont", near Richmond Hill, in the Windsor district, where he later became a grazier and magistrate. Died at Mudgee in 1861. His sister Elizabeth married George Cox of Winbourn, Mulgoa. His brother Archibald discovered the Bell line of road in 1823.

Alexander Berry (1781-1873) was a Sydney merchant, settler at the Shoalhaven, and member of the Legislative Council from 1828-61, residing at Crows Nest House on Sydney's north shore. Berry was a neighbour of Martens, both active supporters and Trustees of St Thomas' Church. Martens visited Berry's property "Coolangatta" on the Shoalhaven River near Nowra between 11-16 April 1860, and Berry gave Martens a glowing reference on 14 September 1863 when he applied for the position of Assistant Parliamentary Librarian.
